7. (S// **Details:** In fulfilling this tasking, all IR/PIRS were addressed with particular attention to the following:

a. TERRORISM:

(1) The Islamic State in Iraq and the Levant (ISIL) also referred to as the Islamic State (IS), has the intent to attack or inspire attacks on Western countries, including Canada. A number of Canadian citizens have travelled to the Middle-East to fight with Islamic-based terror groups, including ISIL, and may return or have returned with intent to cause attacks in Canada. Others have self-radicalized within Canada and may be motivated by extremist/radical messaging to attack, particularly if they perceive interdiction of ISIL to be Western persecution of Muslims. Islamic-based self-radicalization or extremism is not confined to persons of any given ethnicity, country of birth, or up-bringing;
